BOTTLE LANTERN

Materials

- clean two-liter plastic soda bottle
- utility knife
- scissors
- colored tissue paper
- school glue
- paintbrush
- hole punch
- string
- · battery votive candle or LED candle
- tape











Instructions

- 1. Cut the top portion of the bottle off by inserting the utility knife on the curved part then cutting all the way around with the scissors. This will leave you with a large opening at the top.
- 2. Punch 2 holes in opposite sides of the bottle, 1 inch from the top.
- 3. Select the colors of tissue paper you wnat to use. Cut or tear into shapes.
- 4. Put some glue into a jar or plastic bowl with a wide top. Add a little water to it and stir until it is mixed well.
- 5. Dip your paintbrush into the glue and while holding the tissue against the side of the bottle, paint the glue onto the tissue. This will adhere the tissue to your lantern.
- 6. Keep doing this until your entire bottle lantern is covered with tissue. Make sure all the tissue is wet with glue.
- 7. Let it dry.
- 8. Tie a string through the holes you made at the top of the bottle to hang it.
- 9. Tape the underside of the battery candle to the bottom of the lantern. Be sure to use tape so you can remove the candle to switch it on.
